LEMUR COLLAGE

Let's go to Madagascar!

Art Vocabulary

Collage-

a piece of art made by layering and gluing different materials together onto a backing.


Materials

- 1 sheets of any color construction paper
- 1 sheet of white copy paper
- glue
- scissors
- crayons/markers
- the attached worksheets

Directions

1. Place the "Puzzle" on top of the construction paper and cut on the lines to create puzzle pieces.

(Tip: You may want to tape or paper clip the two pages together for young children so that the paper doesn't move as they cut.)

Directions Continued

2. Re-assemble the pieces together and glue onto the white copy paper. Some of the edges might hang off.


Talk about how God MADE the world, He put the land and people together, just like they are MAKING the pieces all fit together. That's exactly what God does! Glue onto a piece of white copy paper. (Tip: Have students place puzzle pieces onto paper first before gluing to ensure they all fit together properly)

3. Color, cut, and glue the Palm Tree and Lemur onto the puzzle. This is the most famous plant in Madagascar, the Traveller's Palm! And the Lemur is probably the most famous animal on the island. Can you think of a tv show or movie where a Lemur was the star?
